C. AFFILIATED PLAYERS: Midget teams may have affiliated a maximum of 8 skaters plus 2 goaltenders; Bantam and Pee Wee teams may have affiliated a maximum of 6 skaters plus 2 goaltenders; Atom and Novice teams may affiliate a maximum of 6 skaters. All affiliated players must be registered with a team from a lower division, age classification or category of hockey in the parent zone. **At all times a player may only be affiliated with one team.**

D. REQUIRED SIGNATURES: All lists must be filed prior to the date of the first use of an affiliated player. The written consent of the affiliated player and his coach must be obtained and filed with the Executive Director. The player's parents must be notified of the intent to affiliate the player. The affiliated players list must have the signed consent of the Zone Commissioner from the Zone with which the player is registered.

E. USE OF AFFILIATED PLAYERS: Coaches must first obtain the permission of (1) the signing player's coach and (2) the player. **It is the obligation of the coach who wants to use the affiliated player to first call and ask the permission of the parent coach**, then the player to ensure that there is no conflicting practice or game of the parent team. It is the responsibility of the parent coach to allow the affiliated player to go up and play or practice when the affiliating team calls, provided that there is no game or practice of the parent team occurring. A properly affiliated player may play an unlimited number of games with his/ her affiliated team prior to January 10. After January 10, he / she may play a maximum of five (5) games with his / her affiliated team (tournament and exhibition games are not counted). A team shall not list any more players and affiliated players on a game sheet than the number of players listed on the registration sheet filed with the SMHA. **EXCEPTIONS:** (i) If a Tier 2 or Tier 3 team has only one goaltender registered, it may dress an affiliated goaltender who will play only if the registered goaltender is sick, injured or suspended; (ii) Teams with less than 15 skaters may dress enough affiliates for all games to have 15 skaters on their roster. Please obtain an AP form for Teams with less than 15 skaters if your team has less than 15 skaters as your team is eligible to affiliate a greater number of players.
